She found a woman named Alice Williams, a recent college graduate who started her own business teaching drama to children. Alice set up engagements so they could perform in plays and do presentations for the local radio station, churches and schools.

Alice inspired children to do just about anything for her. My dad learned to recite a poem and give readings, both in front of crowds and on the radio. These experiences removed his shyness and gave him a lot of self-confidence. “What Alice did for me was very wonderful,” he recalled.
